

Gloucester County provides eight opportunities to responsibly dispose of household special waste items

Gloucester County will provide its residents with eight opportunities to responsibly dispose of household special waste items such as oil-based paints, motor oil, antifreeze, batteries, CFL bulbs, fluorescent tubes, solvents, pesticides, pool chemicals, and other similar items. Collection is free for Gloucester County residents. Businesses are not permitted to participate.

The items can be dropped off at the Gloucester County Solid Waste Complex located at 493 Monroeville Road, South Harrison Township on March 14, April 4, May 9, July 11, Sept. 12, and Oct. 9.

The Gloucester County Public Works Department – located at 1200 N. Delsea Dr in Clayton - will also be accepting materials on May 6 and Oct. 17

Last year, the county accepted 256,859 pounds of material from 2,576 county residents.

All collection events will be held rain or shine and will begin at 8 a.m. No materials will be accepted after 2 p.m.
